

Hye Camp Packing List

Pack for Hye Camp with older clothes and shoes, as things get dirty and mixed up. Keep modesty in mind. Mark your name on thing that you'd want returned if mixed up or lost. Use common sense & closely follow the dress code and guidelines. God is watching.

- Closed-toed shoes and shirts required outside cabins except while swimming.
- Shorts, skirts, dresses should be modest (use "fingertip rule"). Same for slits.
- Avoid clothing with inappropriate symbols or messages, or that is sheer/see-through.
- Choose modest swimsuits and wear cover-ups over swimsuits when moving to/from lake.
